Press Release: 18-1421 Umpqua Bank Robbery

On 06/05/2018, at approximately 1656 hrs, a robbery occurred at the Umpqua Bank, located at 607 S. State St. in Ukiah, CA. The suspect entered the bank and approached the bank teller counter. The suspect handed the bank teller a note which demanded money. The suspect took an undisclosed amount of money in various denominations. The suspect last fled on foot northbound in the area of S. State St. No weapon was seen and the suspect gave no indication that he was armed.

The suspect was described as a white male adult, approximately 20-25 years old, 5'11-6'0 tall, thin build, clean shaven, brown hair, a dark colored baseball hat with an unknown logo on the front, a gray zip up sweatshirt with a dark colored shirt underneath, blue jeans, and sneakers (possibly black/white Converse).
