Statistics

Arrests included: 8 public intoxications, 7 warrant arrests, 3 shopliftings, 3 VOP, 3 domestic violence, 2 battery, 1 unlawful possession of Inhalant, 1 possession of a dirk or dagger/possession of methamphetamine/VOP, 1 possession of a controlled substance, 2 possession of methamphetamine/possession of drug paraphernalia, 1 vandalism.

Officers investigated and took reports of: 7 found properties, 6 City Code violations, 6 vandalisms, 4 traffic collisions, 4 towed vehicles, 2 thefts, 4 CPS/APS Cross reports, 2 mental health evaluations, 1 fraud report, 2 stolen vehicles, 1 burglary.

The Patrol Division's average response time to in-progress calls was just over 3 minutes. The average response time to all calls was just over 8 minutes.

Highlights for the Week

On May 17th, at approximately 8:59am, a UPD officer responded to the 100 block of Ford St. regarding an intoxicated male subject in a vehicle in the area. Upon arrival, the officer located a male subject identified as William Long, a 54 year old transient. The officer observed Long displaying signs and symptoms of alcohol intoxication. Long was placed under arrest for public intoxication and booked into county jail. 17-1404

On May 17th, at approximately 2:29pm, a UPD officer was patrolling the 600 block of Leslie St. when he located a subject identified as Maria Marfil, a 36 year old transient. The officer was aware of several warrants for Marfil's arrest. The UPD officer contacted Marfil and took her into custody without incident. Marfil was booked into county jail. 17-1411

On May 17th, at approximately 11:25am, a UPD officer responded to Burger King for a report of a male subject causing a disturbance. Upon arrival, the officer located the male subject identified as Ronald Valentine, a 56 year old transient. During the contact with Valentine the officer observed Valentine displaying signs and symptoms of alcohol intoxication. On May 19th, at approximately 12:16am, a UPD officer was patrolling the 100 block of S. Orchard Ave. The officer located two subjects on the east side of the building. The first subject was identified as Donald Sharp, a 30 year old transient. The officer found Sharp to be in possession of a controlled substance, drug paraphernalia and in possession of a depressant. The second subject, identified as Carol Curtiss, a 33 year old transient. The officer found Curtiss to be in possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. On May 20th, at approximately 10:24pm, a UPD officer responded to Lucky's Supermarket regarding a male subject who has just shoplifted a cart of grocery items. Upon arrival, the officer located the suspect, identified as Jeremiah Luna a 34 year old transient. A records check of Luna revealed that Luna was on probation and a warrant for Lunas arrest. Luna was placed under arrest for the shoplifting, the warrant, and violation of probation. Luna was booked into county jail. 17-1445

On May 22nd, at approximately 12:04pm, a UPD officer responded to the 200 block of Clara Ave. regarding a male subject sleeping outside. Upon arrival, the UPD officer contacted the subject, identified as Jimmy Isenhart a 45 year old transient. The officer observed Isenhart displaying signs and symptoms of alcohol intoxication. A records check on Isenhart revealed a warrant for his arrest. Isenhart was placed under arrest for public intoxication and the local warrant. Isenhart was booked into county jail. 17-1452

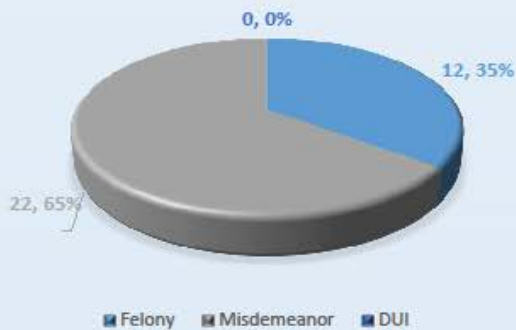

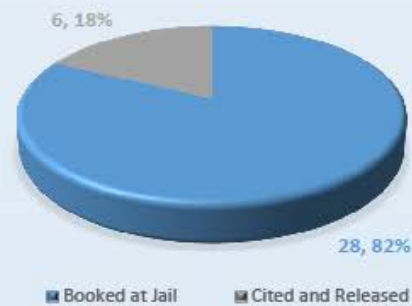

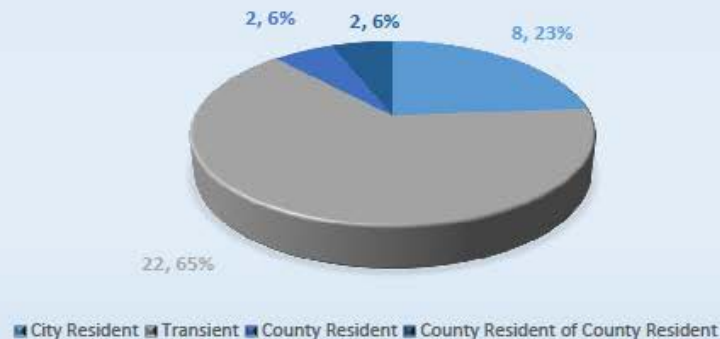
CRIME BREAKDOWN
