Press Release: Vehicle vs bicyclist traffic collision UPD case # 17-2608

On September 11th at about 11:14 am, UPD officers along with fire and ambulance personnel, responded to the intersection of North State and Brush Street, for a reported traffic collision between a vehicle and bicyclist. Upon arrival officers found that the intersection had been cleared and the driver and bicyclist were both in the parking lot of a nearby business. During the subsequent investigation, officers learned that the 23 year old male driver was stopped in his delivery truck, westbound on Brush Street on a red light. When the intersection was clear the driver started to make a right turn to head northbound on North State Street. At the same time, the bicyclist was traveling the wrong direction southbound in a northbound lane of North State Street near the curb edge, when she collided with the delivery truck. The bicyclist received a laceration to her left leg and was transported to Ukiah Valley Medical Center by ambulance, where she was treated for her injury.

Bicycle Safety tips:

- Always wear a helmet.
- Wear bright clothes.
- Go with the traffic flow. Ride on the right in the same direction as vehicles.
- Obey all traffic laws.
- Yield to traffic when appropriate.
- Stay alert at all times.
- Look before turning.
- Watch for parked cars and blind spots.
